Don Schluender spoke about Amendment 4 that will appear on the November ballot. The amendment, labeled "Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion" is extreme. It eliminates virtually all safeguards, including for the health of the mother. It eliminates parental consent for minors, and with exceptions, permits abortion up to birth. Treasurer's Report




The treasurer reported July through April 30st, income of \$145,143 and expenditures of \$93,857, mostly donations and bingo payouts. A separate matter is the Diocese returned the funds the Council had paid, intending to occupy half of the Sheedy Center. Those funds, about \$207k, have been placed in a CD. Thus, total '23 - '24 deposits have been \$352,218
