Peace be with you! September... Growing up the arrival of September meant three things: the 1st bell of the new school year, the kickoff of the new football season and the Albion Area Fair. Ah the Fair, 75+ years running, biggest best little fair around. Tractor pulls, farm animal exhibits, amusement rides, farm equipment displays; then there were exhibits: school art & science projects, pies, flowers (+Mom was a blue ribbon winner for her roses), canning items, arts & crafts and needle works; there's a parade and a Fair Queen, in fact a good friend of mine was Fair Queen our senior year (and almost my prom date, I could've been Royalty!).
