Did you know?

Father McGivney was born on August 12, 1852, in the city of Waterbury, CT, which is about 40 minutes from our headquarters in New Haven, CT.

On August 13 we celebrate his Feast Day as he was beatified October 13, 2020, and he passed away on August 14, 1890, at the age of 38 from the Russian Asian flu pandemic.

He was the oldest of 13 children of these 6 survivors. Two brothers Patrick and John and 4 sisters. Both Patrick and John were Supreme Chaplin; therefore, the Order had a member of the McGivney family as Supreme Chaplin until 1960.

On Friday, June 27, 2025, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The themes that we read in the four Scripture passages was God's care for His flock, the sheep.
