I would like to congratulate Council 8086 for getting off to a great start to the 2025-26 Columbian Year! Only three weeks into the new year, we already have secured ten new members – virtually two thirds to our annual goal of 15. We have already filed the e-paperwork for our new officers (form 185) and council positions (365).

More importantly, the Grand Knight, Program Director, Family Director and Community Director have completed their on-line training – including applicable background checks – well ahead of the deadline set by new State Deputy Mike Gizewski. We've also set up a Fraternal Benefit Event with our Field Agent Jim Booritch, which will be held in



conjunction with our September membership meeting. That leaves the Programs area, four activities each in the fields of Life, Family, Faith and Community. That's never a problem with Council 8086 - we generally double that requirement!

We also held our Installation of Officers on the evening of July 11, and held our first Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity on July 8.

We will hold a rosary prior to our August membership meeting at 6 p.m. in the Church; this is in addition to our First Friday Rosary at 7:45 a.m.

Also thanks to Our Lady Hope for hosting our annual tri-district organizational meeting on Saturday, July 19. We had 44 Knights from 10 councils on hand for a number of informative presentations. Our members Vito Benedetto (Life dinner), Ernie Jackson (Silver Rose), Mike Godbout (Knights on Bikes) and Tim Mell (Duck Derby). Regional Administrator Bob Rasch was joined by his assistant, Gerry Grillo. State Special Olympics chairman Chris Berens made a presentation. Other DDs were Chuck Armstrong (18) and Dr. Patrick Coggins (19).

We're off to a great start – but let's not let off and continue our momentum route to another Star Council award.






KNIGHT OF THE MONTH: SK Sam Tedesco

Everyone who knows District Warden SK Sam Tedesco knows he's one of the hardest working and nicest Knights

in our Council, Assembly 2794 and OLOH parish. Whether he's cooking, serving donuts or working at the Daytona Track, Sam always has a big smile on his face — and he has a way of making everyone around him smile!

A Knight since 1989, Sam is a former Grand Knight, District Warden, District Deputy and held numerous positions at the State level in his home state of Missouri. Sam brought a wealth of leadership experience with him when he and his wife Jean moved to Florida in 2018 and joined our Council the following year.

Sam is always there ready to help as needed, formerly serving as Family Director, and POC for the Road Trash Pickup Team. He's currently a Hurricane Knights



Committed to "spreading the good news," Sam is also very active our parish, serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, Minister to the Sick and User. He also volunteers to help others in the community as a member of the Loaves & Fishes, Grocery Delivery Program, Food Pantry Delivery and F.A.I.T.H. teams.



FAMILY OF THE MONTH: Tom & Christine Hilpert

Christine and Tom Hilpert's journey to marriage and community involvement is a story of faith, life changes, and shared values. Christine grew up near Pittsburgh and Tom near St. Louis, influenced by Catholic teachings about making wise choices when God asks of them during defining moments in time. Christine found her calling in dosimetry through a hospital internship, while Tom shifted from a planned Marine career due to a sports injury to aerospace and defense roles.

Both established roots in Central Florida due to work, family, and personal preferences. Tom settled in Port St Lucie in 2019. Christine came down in 2013. After moving to New Smyrna Beach six year later, she joined Our Lady of Hope—and felt like she should be here.



A friend encouraged Christine to look for a "good, practicing Catholic man" on Catholic Match. Just before she quit the app, a bereavement counselor encouraged Tom to use it to "find a good Catholic girl." The app matched them even though they lived two hours apart. Through the app, they chatted. On St. Valentines Day 2022, the app allowed them a video call. It lasted hours!

This journey led them to Our Lady of Hope parish where they felt spiritually aligned, overcoming the distance through shared faith and values. Both knew that the Holy Sacrament of Marriage should be between three – God, Christine & Tom. They chose OLOH for the ceremony and reception to stand as an example before their family and friends what a Catholic family beginning means.

After their marriage, Christine and Tom became active in parish ministries and committees. Christine trained as a Eucharistic Minister and Sacristan to support her coordination of wedding ceremonies. She ensures that the couples understand each aspect of the Sacrament and why we, as Catholics, practice them. Tom supports her during weddings and is involved with the Parish Planning and Development Committee, looking at the current and future needs of the Parish complex. Both take part in F.A.I.T.H. on various projects.

After prayerful reflection, the couple consolidated homes less than a year ago, deciding on New Smyrna Beach and OLOH as home. They enjoy family life with their children and grandchildren, travel, riding their Can-Am or boating, while embracing their faith and community.


